PIs are a group of nearly 500 genetic disorders of the immune system with varying degrees of severity that occur when one or more parts of the immune system do not work properly, affecting millions of Americans, mostly children.

The PSAs are meant to inspire children and families to imagine healthy futures where children can follow their dreams. There has been a remarkable increase in the reported number of patients diagnosed and treated across the globe because of the PSAs—our messages of hope, advocacy, and action are helping to save lives!
