Dear Public Service Director,

September marks **School Attendance Awareness Month** and the opportune time for Communities In Schools® (CIS) to launch a major new PSA campaign to **combat chronic school absenteeism**.

Nationally, an estimated 26% of public-school students were considered chronically absent last year, up from 15% before COVID, according to research by the American Enterprise Institute. The increases have occurred in school districts of all kinds – urban, suburban, and rural. In poor communities, the rate is 32%. U.S. Department of Education data puts the total number of students at nearly 15 million for school year 2021-2022.

While the problem is straightforward – **students can't learn if they aren't in school** – the reasons are varied and complex. Lack of transportation, mental health issues, food insecurity, no internet access, and poor housing conditions are among the many challenges.

CIS knows that the presence of caring adults, can change everything. **Being Present Matters**. We provide added support to schools in the form of Site Coordinators who work one-on-one with students to ensure they have what they need to engage in learning.

CIS works directly with two million students, and based on our nationally case managed load, 99 percent of them remained in school through the end of the 2023 school year.

Our campaign, **Being Present Matters**, is available in :60, :30 and :15-second spots. We urge you to air these spots as soon as you can.

Thank you in advance for your generous media support – and for being there for us in the many months ahead so that we can **be present** for students and their families in communities across the country.
